1.0 OPENING

The meeting started at 12 noon with an opening prayer by the programme leader for Livestock Science and Sustainable Environment.

2.0 INTRODUCTION

The Chairman welcomed members and representatives of companies that bided for the advertised projects and the general public that attended the meeting. He thereafter, requested for physical identification of the Companies representatives. The Companies representatives were requested to stand for recognition to the admiration of all. After the recognition of

Companies representatives, he informed that the Centre of Excellence in Agricultural Development and Sustainable Environment advertised for the procurement of various items divided into five (5) different lots in two (2) nation-wide newspapers (The Punch and Daily Trust) from 21st March, 2016 to 5th May, 2016. The total number of companies that responded to the publications were eighteen (18) but as at 12noon of 5th May, 2016 which was the closing and opening date only fifteen (15) companies submitted.

The documents submitted, that is, both the technical and financial bids would be opened and the evaluation exercise of both Technical and Financial bid will be done later. This method is called post qualification, this is the method approved by the World Bank. The financial bids of the companies that passed the post-qualification will be evaluated while the lowest responsive bidder(s) would be awarded the project(s).

He stated further that the attendees are assured that the guidelines of both the Bureau of Public Procurement and World Bank would be used as a guide in the procedure of the contract award.

Finally, he introduced the representatives of independent observers of both Professional Body and Civil Society that were present as observers to witness the procedure of the bid opening in accordance with section 19 of the Bureau of Public Procurement Act 2007. He announced that no late bid submission was entertained, the bids of some bidders who came after 12noon were not accepted.

3.0 OPENING OF BIDS LOT BY LOT

The bid opening section was based on the register of bids received, which was prepared using the information on the envelopes. As a result of the bidding procedures twenty-five (25) bids were received comprising of eleven (11) bids in Lot 1, three (3) bids in Lot 2, three (3) bids in Lot 2, two (2) bids in Lot 4 and six (6) bids in Lot 5.

Thereafter, one of the Companies Representatives suggested that submissions should be separated and opened Lot by Lot. The members of the Procurement Planning Committee and all the attendees agreed with the

suggestion and the submission of bid by each Company was certified by Companies representatives to have been duly submitted.

4.0 OBSERVATIONS

- a. One of the representatives of Companies that came late for bid submission (EHIMEN EREMEN INVESTMENT) credited the procedures followed by the Management of the Centre of Excellence in Agricultural Development and Sustainable Environment and confirmed that the whole procedure was transparent.
- b. One of the observers (Professional Body) announced that Companies are mandated to register with Bureau of Public Procurement before Companies can be awarded any job. He also implored the Companies that would be awarded the supply of equipment to supply standard equipment with the provision for installation, training of the end users, genuine warranty and a good maintenance schedule policy. He emphasised that all the above should be incorporated in the award agreement.
- c. One of the observers (Civil Society) also commended the transparency policy adopted in the bid opening exercise.
- d. The representative of **Eagle Scientific and Laboratory Supply Limited** advised that in as much as the Management of the Centre of Excellence in Agricultural Development and Sustainable Environment is considering lowest responsive bidder in accordance to the Bureau of Public Procurement Act 2007, the quality, integrity and standard of equipment to be supplied should not be over looked.
- e. The representative of **OVIVI Ventures Limited** stated that the lowest responsive bidders be complied with in accordance to the Bureau of Public Procurement Act 2007.
- f. The representative of I.T Horizon asked that what would happen to the bids submitted without bid security?

The chairman responded that the instruction was that bid security should be enclosed with the bids before submission and failure to comply with the instruction has disqualified such company.

CONCLUSION

In conclusion, after much deliberations, the Chairman and members of the Procurement Planning Committee noted all the observations and comments and informed the suppliers that the results of both technical and financial bid would be communicated to them before the contracts are finally awarded.

CLOSING

The meeting closed at 2:50pm with a closing prayer by the representative of OVIVI Ventures Limited.
